Sunday 19 April 2009

Tournament entrants make their own way to the Novotel Hydro Majestic, located at 2 Jalan Kia Peng, Kuala Lumpur. Golf registration is available from 5 – 6.30pm and your welcome buffet dinner commences at 7pm. All drinks are at your own expense.

Monday 20 April 2009

Following breakfast, golfers depart for the first day of competition at Royal Selangor golf course at 7.45am for a shotgun start at 8.30am. It is expected that play will take 4.5 hours and following a light lunch, golfers return to the hotel around 4pm. All purchases on course are the responsibility of the player. Scores will be reviewed in the hotel at 6pm.

Non-golfers, after a leisurely breakfast, you depart at 10am for a city tour including the King's Palace, Independence Square and historic buildings. Lunch will be provided at KL Tower.. A return to the hotel is expected by 3.30pm and we hope you join the golfers at 6pm for a review of their first day's play.

Tuesday 21 April 2009

After breakfast, golfers will depart for Kota Permai golf course for the second day of competition. It is intended to depart the hotel at approximately 7.30am and golf will commence at 8.30am. After play, lunch will be served and a return to the hotel is expected by 4.30pm. A review of the team scores will be available at 6pm.

Non-golfers; at 8am join your guide and the WAGA representative for a full day tour of Malacca. This visit will allow you to visit various churches and temples, Jonker Street, A' Famous fort and much more. Lunch and drinks will be provided. Your return to the hotel is expected by 5pm. Don't forget the scoring review at 6pm.

Thursday 23 April 2009

The third day of competition will be held at Clearwater Sanctuary golf course. Your luxury coach departs at 7.30am for a 8.30am shotgun start. Lunch will be served at completion of play and you should be back at 4pm. All scores will be available at 6pm.

Non-golfers can relax in the hotel with a beauty treatment, visit some of the numerous museums or join newfound friends for lunch. It is your choice! Remember, those golfers will want to look at their scores at 6pm and we hope you will join them.

Friday 24 April 2009

The last day of competition for the 24th IAC will be held at Saujana golf course. WAGA expect to depart the hotel at 7.15am and play will commence at 8am with a shotgun start. Lunch will be provided and a return to the hotel is expected by 3.30pm. Drinks are at 7pm and dinner commences at 7.30pm.

Non-golfers – your last chance to shop or visit the various restaurants in the surrounding area. Look at the luggage and wonder just where those purchases are going to fit. Drinks at 7pm with the prize/presentation dinner at 7.30pm. Dress is casual.

Saturday 25 April 2009

Following breakfast, check-out of the hotel to be completed by noon.

Royal Selangor: This course is the founding ground of golf in Malaysia with a long and illustrious history that is associated with birth and dawn of golf in the region. It has played a most prominent role in the evolution of the game in the area and has hosted numerous international tournaments. Amid magnificent displays of flora and fauna, this beautifully landscaped 45 hole course is a true delight and will be a pleasure for the 24th IAC attendees. www.rsgc.com.my

Kota Permai: Since opening in 1998, this Ross Watson course has been a delight to both domestic and international visitors. It has hosted numerous events and is often rated in the top courses in the country. In Malay, the name means serene and beauty and this course provides those qualities to the players. A game of golf here will be remembered, not necessarily for the score but for the experience. WAGA played here in 1998 and are looking forward to returning to the course. www.kotapermai.com.my

Clearwater Sanctuary: This is a 27 hole golf resort, carefully sculptured from a former tin-mining site and its 800 acres of verdant meadows, shimmering lakes, clusters of rain-trees, swaying palms and lush foliage will present a challenge to all levels of golfers. WAGA selected this course as it has received numerous international awards and was designed by Tim Woolbank from Australia. WAGA golfers can expect to play the Raintree and Lakes courses. www.clearwater.com.my

Saujana: The course opened in 1986 and has a great reputation for both the course and its staff. Carved out of a former palm and rubber plantation, it is set among rolling hills and tranquil lakes, just waiting for those errant shots. There are two courses and both are renowned. Again, numerous domestic and international events have been held here and those that joined us in 1998 may well remember it. Kuala Lumpur is served by many local and foreign airlines. At the time of this brochure being prepared, WAGA was in discussion with MAS about reduced airfares from all countries and for all attending the 24th IAC. It has not been confirmed but it will be published on www.wagagolf.com if and when it happens.

Discount airfares are readily available on most carriers. A word of caution, most discount carriers will charge excess for golf clubs. Travel to and from the airport can be done by taxi, bus and by train. The weather will be warm and humid, light clothing is recommended and naturally, head-ware always. Suitable drinking water is available at all hotels and golf courses.
