The Golf Courses > The Golf Courses

Our chosen hotel has two international courses, Les Chateaux and The Vignes.

The Chateaux Course was designed by American Bill Coore. It has wide fairways lined with heather, gorse, broom and quality greens which are subjected to the influence of Atlantic winds. It is necessary to play with the strategy of an environment that is not your home course. It is listed as the 12th best course in France and has hosted the French Open. A par 71 of 6316metres.

The Vignes Course - a par 71 of 6220metres designed by Canadian Rod Whitman. Set in a regional landscape, the beauty of the moors and maritime pines provide a challenge for golfers of all levels. Long par 5 holes, carefully designed greens, judiciously placed bunkers, all create an aura of fun and challenge of golf.
