Golf Courses

Both have been designed by world renowned Gary Player.

The Lost City Golf Course is an 18 hole desert style layout with spectacular views across the bushveld. Unique to the par 72 course are the crocodiles on the 13th par 3 hole. The course covers 100 hectares and incorporates 28,000sq metres of water features. Buggy supplied, caddies can be hired. Practice facilities available.

The Gary Player Country Club course features an 18hole layout and is a par 72. Great design and multiple tees make it enjoyable for players of all standards. Classed as a "must do" for golfers visiting Africa, WAGA feel that it will be a fitting part of the tournament. Buggies NOT allowed, caddies and practice facilities available.

General Information

There are no direct flights into Sun City. Normal entry to South Africa is via either Johannesburg or Capetown and Sun City transfers are effected three times a day from the closest airport. That way you can enjoy the wonderful scenery but not worry about driving. If you wish to hire a car, most companies have airport offices. Hiring a car might allow you to visit nearby game parks.
