The course design and environment

Tomojiro Maruyama, a Japanese Golf Course Architect, was engaged by MID (the original owners) to design the Resort's course, which was opened in 1990.

In early 2002 preparations began for a complete re-design on the western side of the resort for a new nine-hole course. The new 9 holes were designed by Graham Marsh Golf Design and opened in 2004.

RACV Royal Pines Resort's championship layout provides three challenging, 18 hole course combinations, with undulating terrain and magnificent greens in a lush, tropical setting.

> General Information

The Gold Coast has Virgin, Jetstar and Tiger Airways flights and if you wish to travel to Brisbane, then you can reach the hotel via bus or rail transfers. Nerang railway station is the station to disembark and regular taxis and bus services attend. There are direct flights from Asia and from USA and Europe; flights can be made to either Sydney or Brisbane.

Car hire is available at all airports but WAGA recommend that if driving in Australia, your licence is required and care needed.
